Theater in the Woods Celebrates 10 Years

Caponi Art Park's 2010 season will showcase high-caliber performances and special activities

Eagan, MN – May 24, 2010– This summer marks the 10th anniversary of outdoor concerts in Caponi Art Park's Theater in the Woods. Nestled in the park's hilly landscape and made intimate by a canopy of trees, Theater in the Woods provides a unique setting for theatrical, musical and literary performances. The theater is a large outdoor amphitheater that boasts a large brick open-air stage, near perfect acoustics, plentiful grassy and ledge seating, and the feeling of the North Woods right in the middle of Eagan.

Work on the Theater in the Woods began in 1998 after the "Storm of the Century" hit the area, blowing down hundreds of trees in the future amphitheater site. It took an entire season to remove the damaged trees and two more seasons to shape the grounds and build the stage. The Theater in the Woods was built with a minimal budget, a bobcat and by hand, one block at a time. In spite of all the work that went into creating the amphitheater, it still looks untouched as though it always has been this way.



Special family-friendly activities are scheduled throughout the summer season to celebrate and mark this milestone and Ring Mountain Creamery will be selling ice cream at each event. The *Summer Performance Series* brings some of the most talented regional and local artists to perform at Caponi Art Park. **All concerts begin at 6:30pm in**

the Theater in the Woods and a \$4 per person donation is suggested.
