

## Park Attractions

**Miles of Trails** wind throughout the park's 60-acres. Walking the trails is the best way to experience this urban oasis.

**Sculpture Garden** is a 20-acre sculpture in itself. The garden features sculptures by park founder Anthony Caponi scattered along the rolling hills and wooded trails.

**Theater in the Woods** is a unique setting for theatrical and musical performances nestled in the park's hilly landscape and made intimate by the canopy of trees. The amphitheater was completed in 2000.



## Programs

Caponi Art Park offers a variety of family-friendly programs including the **Summer Performance Series, Family Fun Tuesdays, Shakespeare Festival, Medieval Fair, and Poets in the Park Teen Poetry Slam.**

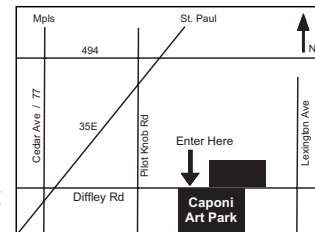

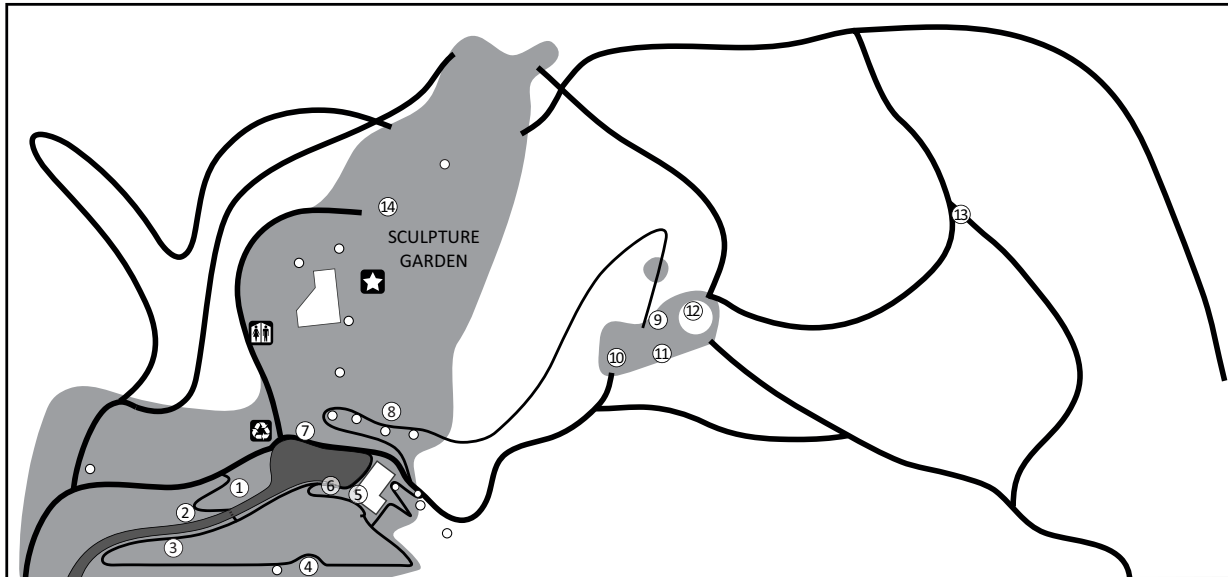


## Visitor Map

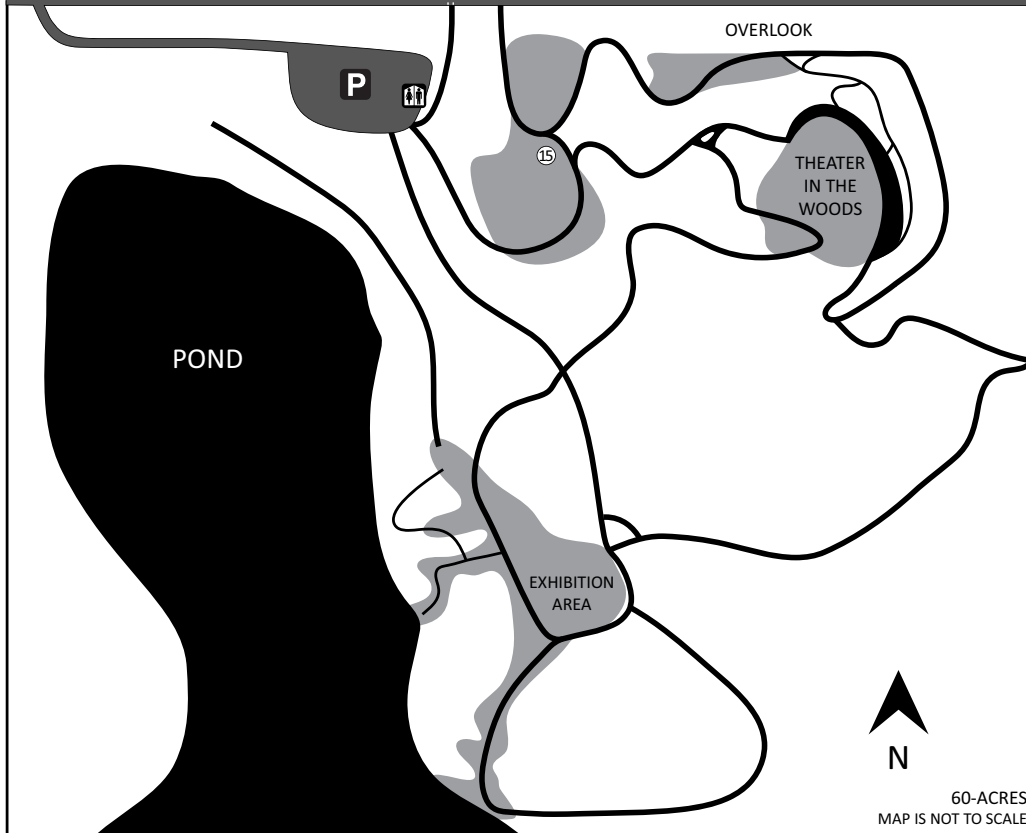
