Sign up for a workshop and learn how to translate your unique design into an open faced sand mold that will be filled with molten metal at the public iron pour. Students will gain a basic understanding of metal casting and come away with an object of their design. All ages are welcome! No previous experience required. Families with young children can work together.

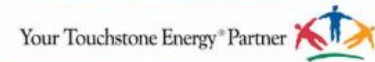
